

Poole, daughter of Isaac Poole

Mr J. H. Roberts. J.P., held a magisterial inquiry at Girgarre on Tuesday last, to ascertain the cause of the death of a daughter of Isaac Poole, a farmer, residing in that parish.

The father deposed that the deceased was fifteen years of age. A few days since she got drenched with the rain while returning home from school, and a day or two afterwards complained of pains in her stomach. She continued ill for two days, but he did not think there was anything serious the matter till a short time before her death, when it was too late to send for the doctor, who resides some ten miles away. They did all they could for the child during the time she was ill.

A verdict of death from natural causes was returned.

The deceased was buried in the Rushworth Cemetery yesterday, and was followed to the grave by a large number of relations and friends. The funeral service was read by the Rev. Mr Madigan. Much sympathy is felt for the parents in their sudden bereavement.
