A magisterial inquiry was held before Mr Wigg, J.P., on Sunday last, for the purpose of ascertaining the cause of the death of Antonio Radoslovich, who was found dead in his bed in Growler's Gully, Rushworth, the same morning.

From the evidence it apposed that the deceased had been in the colony about 15 years, and had been mining in Rushworth for about a third of that time, but latterly had been able to do very little in consequence of failing health.

A verdict of death from natural causes was returned. Dr Myers, who was consulted by the deceased a short time since, stated that he was then suffering from an incurable disease of the heart.
