A magisterial enquiry was held yesterday by W. Wigg, Esq., J. P., and a finding was recorded in accordance with the medical testimony that the cause of death was apoplexy.

Deceased was the brother of Messrs F. and W. Smith, of Rushworth and Murchison, chemists, and was a very old resident of the former town.
