

## **Robert Stockdale**

**Rushworth Chronicle**

**4 July, 1930**

The death occurred at the Mooroopna Hospital on Thursday, 19th inst., of Mr. Robert Stockdale, of Rushworth, at the age of 53 years.

The late Mr. Stockdale had been in ill-health for the past seven years, during which time he was incapacitated from following any employment.

He was taken to the Mooroopna Hospital about three weeks before his death, having been a patient at that institution on a previous occasion.

He was born at Cooma, N.S.W., and lived in Rushworth and district all his life. He made many friends who regret his death.

He leaves a widow and a family of three sons and four daughters, the youngest being 11 years of age.

The funeral took place on Friday last, the remains being brought to Rushworth and interred in the Rushworth Cemetery.

Amongst the floral tributes was a wreath from the officers and men of the Royal Air Force at Laverton, the late Mr. Stockdale's son, Norman, being employed as a mechanic in the force.

The burial service was read by Rev. Canon Grist.
