

**Son of Mr and Mrs Thomas Davies**

Mr and Mrs Thomas Davies, of Lauderdale, suffered a sad misfortune on Sunday last in the death of their only son, a fine young fellow of five years of age.

It appears that the child only took ill a few days previously, and on the Saturday became alarmingly bad. On a consultation between Drs Utber and Florence it was agreed to at once convey him to the Mooroopna Hospital for operation. The journey, however, proved too much, and he succumbed as stated. The cause of death was appendicitis.

The remains were conveyed to Mrs A. Davies' residence in Rushworth, from which place the funeral took place on Monday afternoon. The Rev. Church ward conducted the funeral service.
