CASEY. -- On the 3rd April, suddenly, Thomas, dearly loved husband of Leleda, father of Little Mary and baby Jim, of Finley, loved eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. P. P. Casey, of "Tantrum", Thule, New South Wales; loved brother of Mary (Mrs Lambden), Bessie (Mrs. J. Barlow), Annie (Mrs. McMahan), Louie (Mrs Holshchier), Kathleen (Mrs. H. Barlow), Philip, Sis (Mrs. W. Hayes), Ada (Mrs. McDougall), Marjory (Mrs. J. Safe) and Ben. R.I.P.

The death occurred on Tuesday of Mr. Thomas Casey, of Finley, N.S.W., a former Rushworth resident.

He was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. P. P. Casey, Thule, N.S.W., and formerly of Rushworth, and was aged 48 years. Mrs. H. Barlow and Mrs. J. Barlow Rushworth are sisters, as also is Mrs. A. H. Lambden who just recently left Rushworth.

We understand Mr. Casey took suddenly and was rushed to Melbourne for treatment by specialists, but despite the best medical attention sank rapidly and died as stated.

The sudden death was a great blow to the family, which is very well-known and highly thought of in this district, and to the sorrowing widow and two children, Mary and Jim.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery yesterday (Thursday) afternoon.
