A painfully sudden death occurred on May 18, at "Paringa Vale" Rushworth, when Mr. Walter John McIntosh passed away at the age of 61 years.

The deceased gentleman was apparently normal health and went about his duties as usual. After cranking his truck he could not get the engine to start and he endeavoured to push it out of the garage. Evidently the effort was too great for he was found lying near the vehicle, having passed peacefully away.

The deceased gentleman was highly respected by a very wide circle of friends and had carried on grazing and farming pursuits at "Paringa Vale" for the past 14 years.

He was born at Windsor (Melbourne) and was a son of Mr. Donald McIntosh. At the age of 33 years he married Miss Vera Unita Geach and six children were born of this happy union, the family comprising James Walter, Reginald (A. I. F.), Esther Vera, Eric Rupert (deceased), Donald William, and Frank.
