A very old identity of Rushworth and district passed away on Sunday last in the person of Mr Wm. Crilly. Deceased, who had resided in Rushworth for 46 years, was only ill for three months, and at the time of his death was living with his daughter, Mrs Jas. Lawrie, Wanalta.

He was 75 years of age and was a colonist of 51 years.

The cause of death was bronchitis.

Deceased had a family of nine children — five sons and four daughters.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Tuesday, a large number of persons according him the last tribute of respect.

The Rev. J. R. Weir read the funeral service.
