# Rushworth Chronicle

The late Mr W. C. Lloyd, who, as reported in our issue of 14th inst., died on 13th August, was born at Tanunda, South Australia, on 23rd December, 1854. He left South Australia with his parents and came to Victoria in 1855.

After travelling round the diggings they came to Rushworth in 1856, but after a short stay in Rushworth, they went to the gold-fields near Bendigo, but eventually returned to Rushworth in 1859 and settled at Old Ned's Gully.

He had lived at Rushworth ever since. He followed the diggings in Rushworth for many years.

The late Mr Lloyd delivered the first copies of the first newspaper published in Rushworth (the "Waranga Echo," published by the late Mr Crimp) when he was a lad of 9 years of age.
