Sudden Death.

A very sudden death occurred at the Waranga Basin on Saturday last.

Mr William Doyle, a resident of that place, was returning home from Murchison, and when within a couple of miles of the Basin township he was apparently overtaken by heart seizure, for he was later discovered in an unconscious condition in the vehicle.

Dr Utber, of Rushworth, was at once communicated with, but to no avail, for the sufferer passed away without regaining consciousness. The doctor had been attending deceased for some months past for heart trouble, therefore a certificate of death was given to that effect.

Deceased was 70 years of age, and leaves a wife to mourn him. The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Monday, Rev. Father Tehan reading the burial service, whilst Mr E. F. Anderson had charge of the mortuary arrangements.
